I am a resident of the neighbouring building at 20 Prospect Place, located above CEX on Montague Street. Our property includes	

skylights that face your development site, and I am writing to express some concerns regarding the proposed works.

My primary concern is the potential loss of privacy, as the new construction may allow occupants or visitors to look directly into my flat. Additionally, I am worried about the reduction of natural light through our skylights.

Could you please provide access to the proposed plans, or confirm whether there will be any west-facing windows or terraces that overlook our building?

Finally, during the previous period when scaffolding was erected, the alarm system frequently triggered, and there were incidents of individuals climbing the scaffolding and accessing our roof. This not only raised serious privacy issues but also posed a security risk to both properties. I would appreciate reassurance that appropriate measures will be taken to prevent such issues from recurring.
