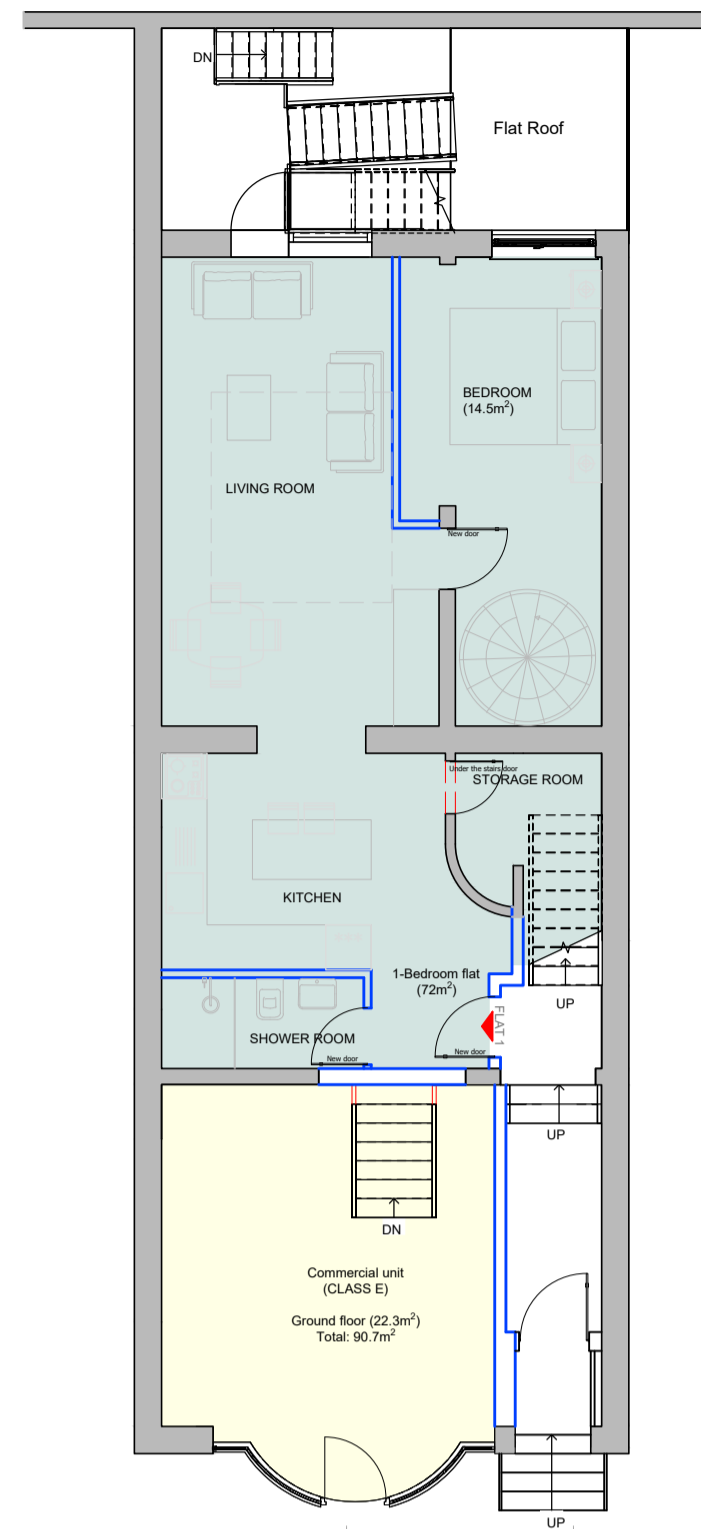
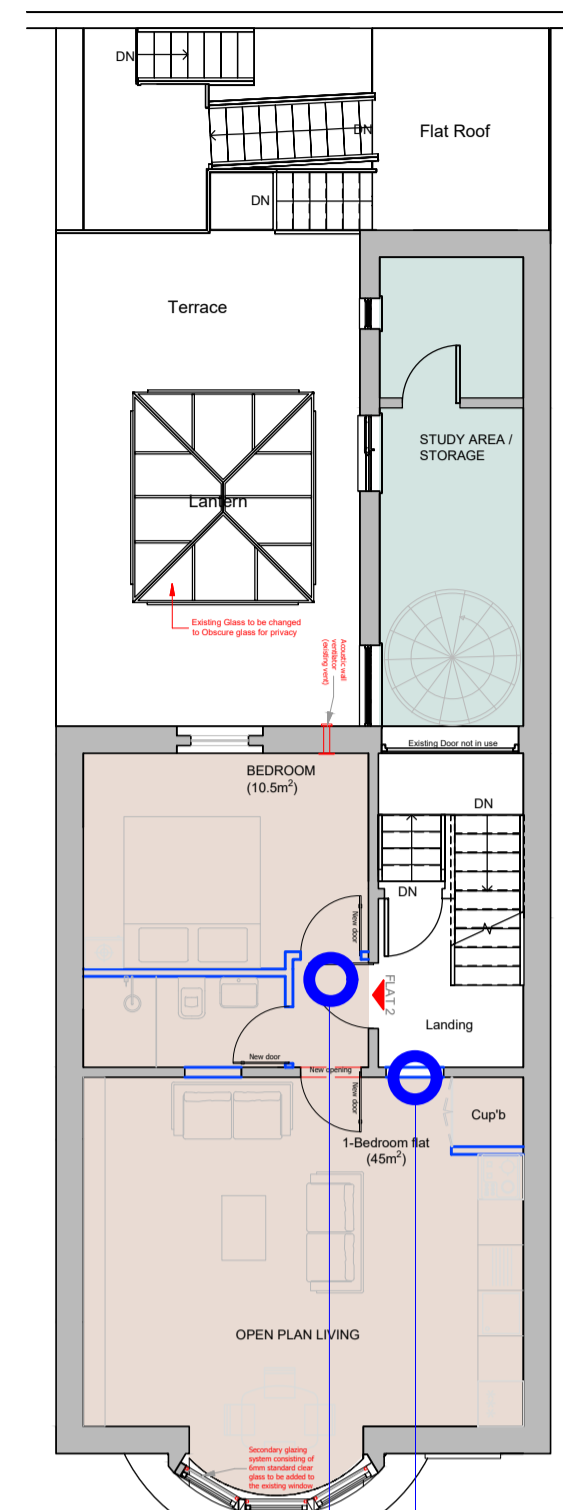


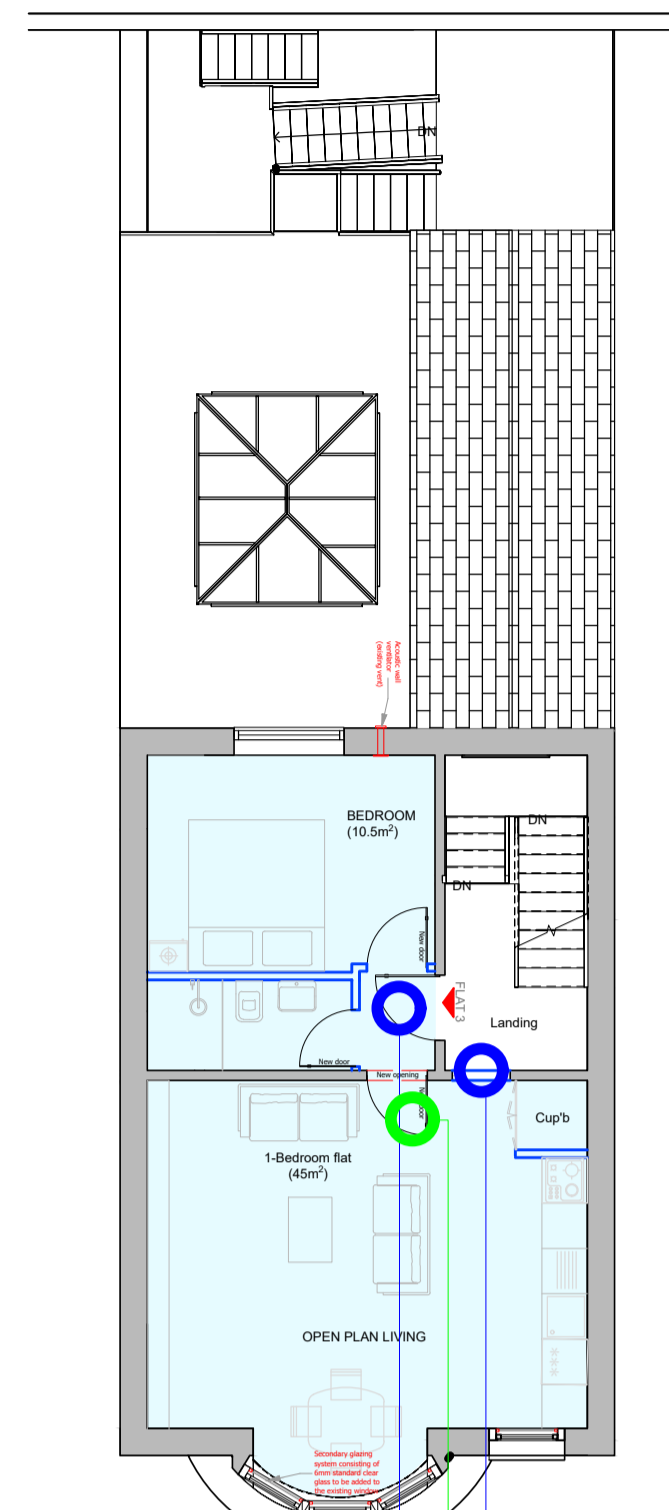
LOWER GROUND FLOOR

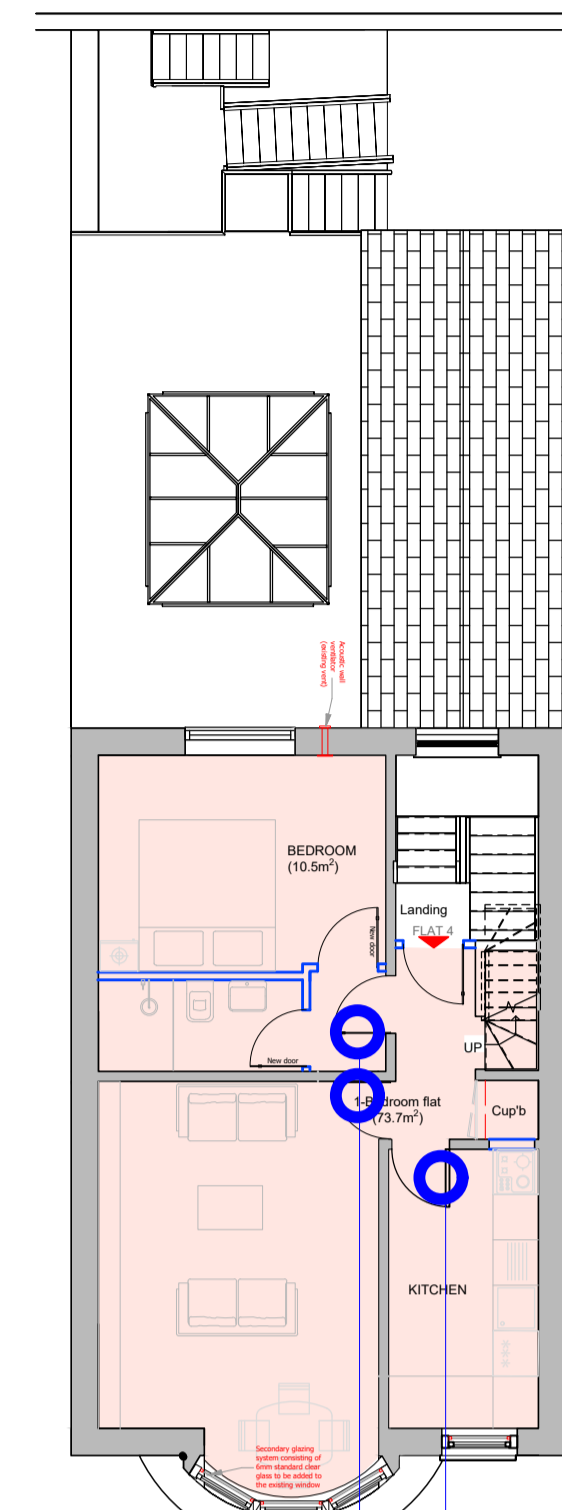
GROUND FLOOR
No loss of original doors



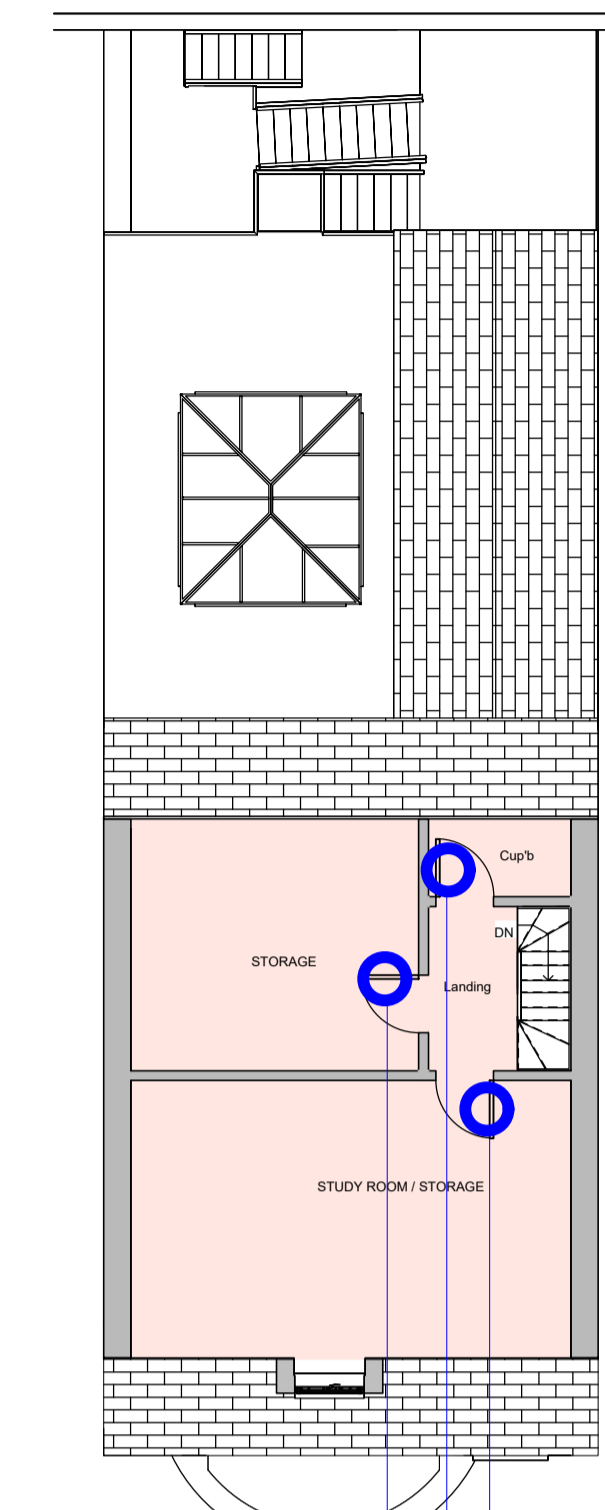
FIRST FLOOR

No loss of original doors

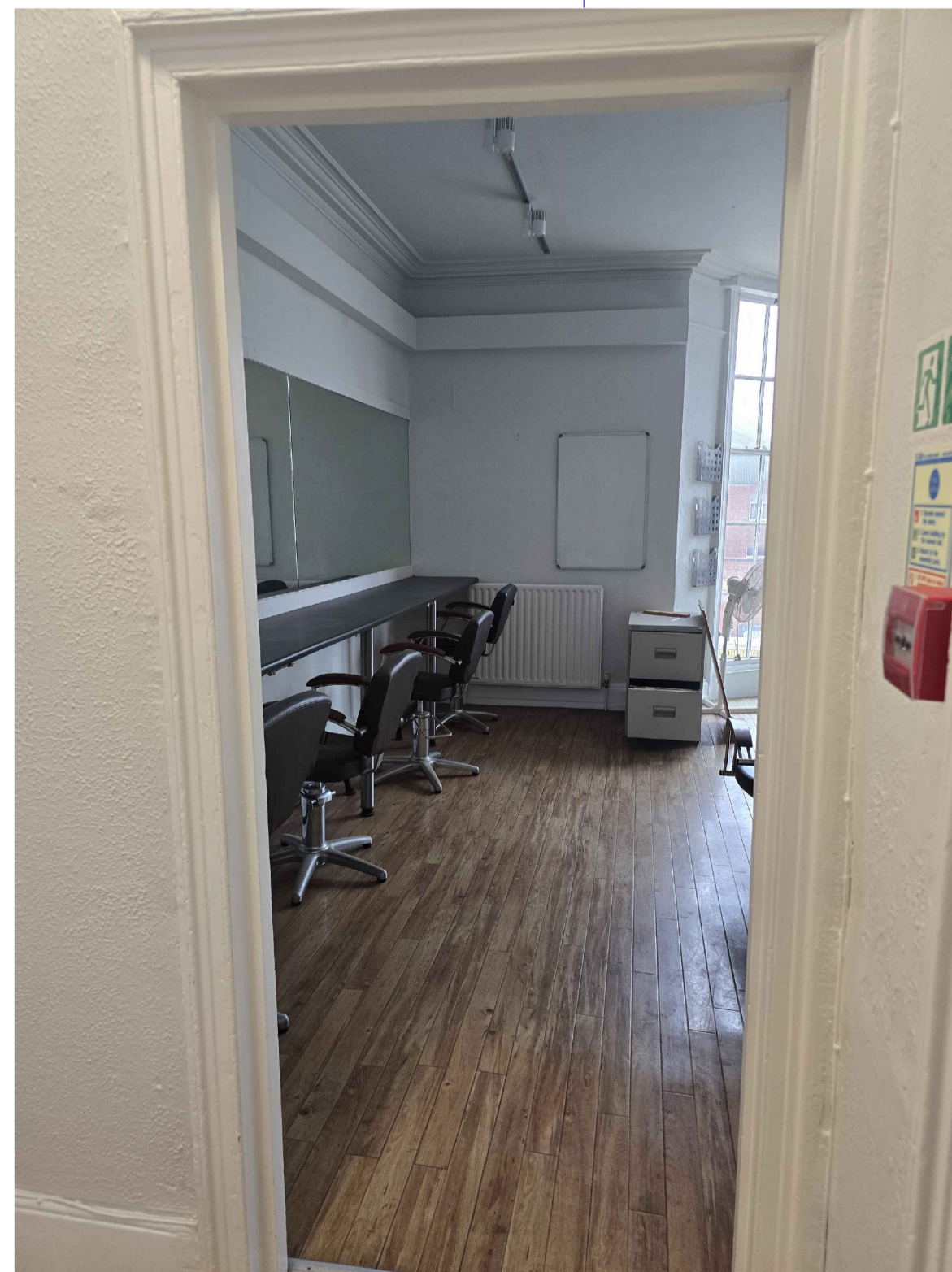


FOURTH FLOOR

Existing doors within Flat 4 are retained. These doors are not required to be fire-resisting, even though the doors on the third floor are fire-resisting ones, as they do not form part of the compartmentation.
Retention of these doors avoids unnecessary loss of historic fabric and accords with the principle of minimum intervention.
