Comments:	<p>Further to my previous comments I notice that there is inadequate, indeed non-existent, turning space in the proposed development. Lorries delivering large items such as furniture, building materials etc. would be unable to turn and therefore be forced to reverse out near the A27 junction. This would be an obvious hazard. Reversing into the proposed service road would be equally dangerous.</p> <p>The loss of habitat, wildlife, trees in this diverse wetland are would be inexcusable.</p> <p>Flooding and drainage are already a serious issue in the area and I do not believe the current infrastructure can cope with the additional proposed load.</p> <p>Access to the site for the necessary construction vehicles would also be inadequate and dangerous.</p> <p>The whole scheme is a gross overdevelopment and would negatively impact the adjoining properties.</p> <p>Vehicle access across the Westbound cycle route would be dangerous due to the short distance between cyclists entering the Old Shoreham Road parallel to the A27 and the proposed entrance to the development service road. As a cyclist I know this is already a dangerous spot with traffic turning in from the A27 and vehicles often parked causing obstructed views.</p>
