As my sister Teresa Slatter has already said regarding my mother Barabara Cole and the planning applications AWDM/1544/25 and AWDM/1494/25, I second her objections as put so eloquently below.

I am strongly objecting to these plans to build extra bedrooms on to Linfield House. My mother, Barabara Cole, is a resident of Richmond Suite, which will be the most adversely affected part of the home. As someone who is suffering from dementia, my Mum's living space is so important to her. When we were deciding where she was going to live, we were so impressed with the facilities on offer: the lovely family room at the end of the corridor, where visitors can sit with residents; the beautiful garden dedicated to the residents with dementia and the views afforded to the living room from being surrounded by plants, trees and wildlife. Last summer we sat in the garden with Mum on many occasions. As an avid gardener before she became unwell, this space really benefitted both my mum and family members and friends. Due to her condition, it is getting harder to take Mum out. With the garden being built on, this opportunity to spend invaluable time outside will be lost. I am also concerned about the impact all the building works will have on very vulnerable people – the noise, chaos and mess, as well as strangers tramping in and out. This is not what we signed up for!
