I refer to your consultation email dated 26th February 2025. The airport safeguarding team has assessed the proposal in accordance with the CAA CAP 168 and we have no aerodrome safeguarding objection to the proposal.

However, we would like to draw your attention to the following:

Crane advice:

Due to the site being within 6km of Brighton City Airport the crane operator is required to submit all crane details such as maximum height, operating radius, name and phone number of site manager along with installation and dismantling dates to the CAA Airspace Coordination and Obstacle Management Service (ACOMS) system.

Once crane notification has been received from the CAA, Brighton City Airport safeguarding team will assess and issue the necessary crane permit. No cranes should operate on site until a crane permit has been issued.
