Dear planning permission,

I am emailing to voice my concerns and object to the proposed planning permission of the above case.

I am aware of the 75 l/s flood risk. The proposed dwellings will sit on top of the Ladywell Stream and would cause irreparable damage to the surrounding area, not to mention the disruption and safety concerns during the build with large lorries etc driving to and from the site.

The land has already been rejected from one planning, the July 2024 Appeal Refusal (APP/Y3805/W/23/3334241).

I have recently moved to Cross Road and already concerned about the possibility of flooding and further road closures around the green, similar to the ones a few years ago, southern water had to use industrial pumps for. The noise was so disturbing and I can't imagine what it was like to live on Cross Road and nearer areas at the time.

We cannot create further problems to add to the flood risk, the risk and harm to hundreds of homes and local businesses, the cost of repairing damage of the council and southern water would also have to bear.
